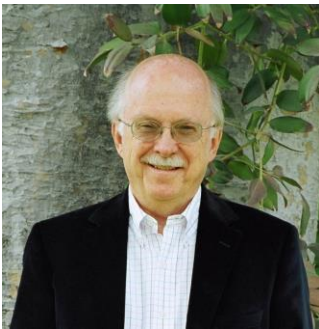
## Taste of History Event Recaps
