A sign for Elm Terrace Shopping Plaza will also be on the left hand side. Proceed ½ block to the church (on the left). Park at the side or behind the church.

From Interstate 470, go east on I-470 to Exit 4, (Bethlehem). At the end of the off ramp turn right on Spruce Street towards WV Rt. 88. Get into the left lane before reaching the traffic light at the top of the hill and take Rt. 88 North down the hill. At the bottom of the hill turn right on E. Cove Ave. The church is a couple of hundred yards on the left. Go past the church building and turn left into the parking lot.
